In the All Kerala CBSE Athletic meet (under 17 girls category) she set new meet records, 10.92metres in Shot Put and 28.45 metres in Discus Throw with Gold medals. In the National meet held at Raipur Chhattisgarh, Gopika Sunil of class 9 broke her own Shot put record by throwing 11.21m (previously 10.92 m in CBSE state meet). In Discus throw too she broke her own record by throwing 30.6m and acquired the 7th position in the National Level and 1st position in South India.
