First and foremost, with pride let me put forward the excellent results of the class 10 & 12 CBSE board examinations.

In the AISSCE (Std XII) 2022-23 batch, 17 students secured A1 in all subjects .

From Science stream, Sriram J Sadasivan with 98.2% is the school topper and Niveditha Sreejith.with 96.4% is the school topper ,from the Commerce stream. Out of 118 students appeared for the exam,83 students secured distinction & 33 students First Class.

In the AISSE (Std X) 2022-23 batch, out of 137 students, 111 students secured distinction, 21 students secured A1 in all subjects. Aparna Menon was the school topper with 98.8%.
